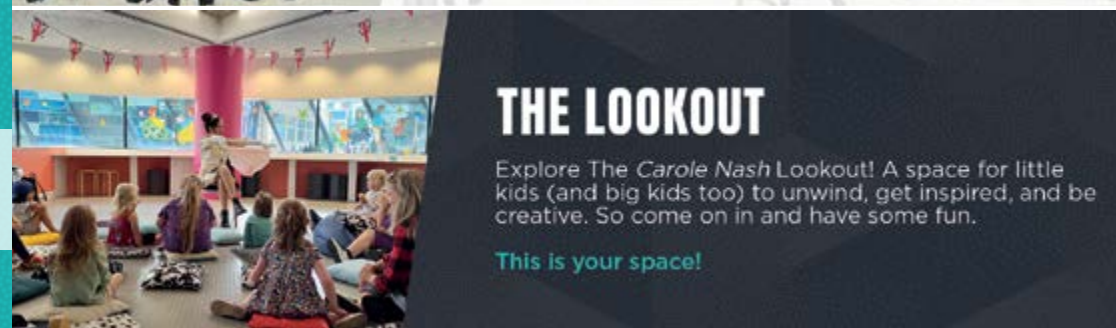
PIER EIGHT RESTAURANT
