## The Village

The Lowry no longer operates a backstage canteen.

The Village is a backstage Green Room where visiting Company Members may meet and eat their own food. There are two vending machines which serve free hot drinks, fridges, microwaves and a Toaster. The vending machines accept card payments only.

As The Village is a shared area, we ask all Visiting Company Members to treat the space with respect and to clear up after themselves. There are bins and cleaning materials provided for this purpose.

## Parking and Transport

Please note there is NO parking available at the Lowry.

The nearest car park to the venue is Quayside MediaCity UK (approx. 200 yds)

Tickets are issued at the barrier upon driving into the car park . No payment is required at the pay stations.

You can purchase a discounted day rate parking ticket at The Lowry Box Office at a cost of £6:50 for 9 hours parking – please ask at stage door for box office opening hours that day.

Once purchased the discounted day rate ticket will then replace the ticket issued upon arrival.

Upon exiting the car park insert your ticket to lift the barriers.

Quayside MediaCityUK is a completely separate business with no links to The Lowry and we have no control or influence over the Car Park.

The Lowry houses the largest public collection of paintings and drawings by LS Lowry in the world. Featuring some of his most famous and important works this exhibition shows an artist remarkable for his diversity and fearless innovation.

Claire Stewart, curator of The Lowry Collection at The Lowry, said: “We’re proud to house the world’s largest public collection of Lowry work – and in extending the exhibition in this way we further strengthening that position as the home of LS Lowry.

“Some of the new works on display haven’t been seen in public for many years and we are grateful to the owners for the opportunity to present them to our gallery visitors. This new exhibition will also look at Lowry’s contemporaries and highlight what life was like in Salford in the early 1900s.”

There are over 400 works in the collection, 57 of which are oil paintings. Alongside the works of art is an archive containing thousands of items ranging from photographs to press cuttings and exhibition catalogues. Both the collection and archive were formed by Salford Museum & Art Gallery and transferred to The Lowry in 2000. A selection of highlights from the Collection can always be seen on display in our permanent **LS Lowry - The Art & The Artist** exhibition alongside works on loan from important private collections throughout the UK.
